We've had visits this week from **Edinburgh Community Food, Inspiring Scotland**, and the **Postcode Lottery Trust**. It's always wonderful to be able to welcome people on site so that they can see for themselves all of the hard work put in by every single one of you, however you're supporting us with your time and energy.

Speaking of your support, we're also asking you all to be especially mindful of **personal and environmental hygiene** as we're now in **Norovirus** ("Winter Vomiting Bug") season. As you may be aware, it's a highly transmissible virus that is spread through touch, breath, and eating contaminated food. The symptoms are feeling suddenly sick, vomiting, and diarrhoea with the latter typically lasting 48 hours. On all levels this is a real risk to us as an organisation, as an outbreak could mean suspension of the operation and the risk of wider transmission across staff and volunteer base and families, as well as our service users.

You can help with our defence against this with regular hand washing, the regular cleaning of all touch points, and staying away if you are unwell - not returning for a shift until you have been symptom free for 48 hours. We will be reminding everyone about hand washing when they arrive and regular sanitising and hand washing before and during a volunteering shift.

Note hand sanitiser itself is not effective with the Norovirus virus - hand washing is. But sanitiser and sanitising is a key part of our broader hygiene and prevention response.
