That's it! You'll get an email confirming you've joined the team, and then we'll be in touch with more information and fundraising tips! If you've already signed up for a race and would like to fundraise for us, you just need to follow step 2 above.

By registering with us and creating a fundraising page - which works in exactly the same way as a GoFundMe or JustGiving page - it's already built into our website and donation platform, and means we can claim GiftAid on relevant donations. It also makes it easier for us to see everyone who is kindly fundraising for us so that we can support your amazing efforts!

If you've already signed up and you've already set up a fundraising page elsewhere, please let us know so that we know you're running with us and we can support you!
